WHAT IS SALT?

SALT is an extracurricular club designed to allow students the opportunity to improve their reading abilities and expand their literary knowledge while competing in a friendly and positive environment. Reading, quiz practice, and club competitions are done through your school in preparation for the area-wide tournament against other SALT teams from area schools.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Any 3rd-6th grade student with teacher approval can participate on a SALT team. Teams compete in either the 3rd-4th Grade Division or the 5th-6th Grade Division. A team's division is determined by the oldest participant on the team.

WHAT BOOKS DO WE READ AND QUIZ ON?

Reading selections include family-friendly books from the following genres: Adventure, Mystery, Classics, Historical Fiction, Bible, Fantasy, and Non-fiction. Students quiz using questions based on content from books on the SALT reading list (see other side of this bookmark). The 3rd-4th Grade Division will quiz over the first 12 books and the 5th-6th Grade Division will quiz over all 16 books.

WHEN AND WHERE DO WE PARTICIPATE?

Students participate in their school's SALT club for practices and pre-tournament competitions. Dates, times, and locations for your school's team to practice and compete are determined by your coach or club administrator. The area-wide tournament for all participating schools is hosted at Salem Academy Elementary School in the spring.

HOW DO WE JOIN THE CLUB?

Students can join their school's SALT club by speaking to the coach or club administrator.
