## WHAT IS SALT?

#### SALT STANDS FOR "SALEM AREA LITERATURE TOURNAMENT" AND IS A COMPETITIVE READING CLUB FOR STUDENTS.

This extracurricular club is designed to allow students the opportunity to improve their reading abilities and expand their literary knowledge while competing in a friendly and positive environment. Reading, quiz practice, and club competitions will be done through your school in preparation for the area-wide tournament against other SALT teams from area schools.

# WHO CAN PARTICIPATE ON A TEAM?

#### ANY 3RD-6TH GRADE STUDENT WITH TEACHER APPROVAL CAN PARTICIPATE ON A SALT TEAM.

Teams compete in one of three grade level divisions: 3rd-4th or 5th-6th. A team's division is determined by the oldest participant on the team. Schools must have a coach and school staff member who oversees and administers the club (may be the same person). It is up to your school to determine student limits for your club and school competitions. For clubs with multiple teams competing in the area-wide tournament, each team must have a coach with them at all times.
